

ASA Sports Coach

(Basketball, Football, and Volleyball)

This is a non-contract position. The After School Activities (ASA) Sports Coach will be needed to lead ASA sessions in a range of sports to be held Mondays to Fridays between 2.30 PM – 5.30 PM, excluding school holidays. The position holder may also be required to work during weekends.

The ASA Sports Coach provides coaching in their relevant sports to students of all levels, ages, and ability in accordance with the ASA programme, and completes other sport-related and administrative duties as may be directed.

The ASA Sports Coach will:

1. Provide effective lead coaching in their relevant sport while ensuring all sessions are fun, safe, and meaningful.
2. Coach sports teams and assist other coaches in planning and organising teams for extra-curricular sessions, competitions, and tournaments.
3. Follow all guidelines, policies, and procedures outlined by the school. Department.
4. Report back to the Physical Education (PE) Department on student progress.

The ASA Sports Coach should:

1. Hold a degree in PE or other relevant fields of study, preferably with relevant coaching qualifications.
2. Be effective in working with and training children of different ages and abilities.
3. Be energetic, self-motivated and results-oriented.
4. Have excellent communication and people skills.
5. Have experience in coaching in a multi-cultural environment.

The pay will range from PhP 250 per hour - PhP 1,000 per hour and be tailored based on the qualifications and experience.
