After-School Activities Sports Coach

The **After-School Activities (ASA) Sports Coach** will lead ASA sessions in **FOOTBALL** or **BASKETBALL** to be held Mondays to Fridays between 2:30 to 5:30 in the afternoon, not including school holidays. The position holder may also be required to work during weekends. **This is a non-contract position.**

Specifically, amongst all other tasks, the ASA Sports Coach:

1. To provide effective coaching in basketball or football ensuring all sessions are planned and fun, safe, and meaningful.
2. To work collaboratively with other coaches in planning and organising teams for extra-curricular sessions, competitions, and tournaments.
3. To report and monitor player progress at regular intervals.

Qualifications:

1. Holder of a degree in Physical Education, Sports Science, or other relevant fields of study, preferably with coaching qualifications and/or experience in football or basketball coaching.
2. Effective in working with and training children of different ages and abilities.
3. Energetic, self-motivated and results-oriented, with excellent communications skills.
4. Possesses tax identification number (TIN); foreign applicants must have valid working visa/permit.
