2. Motivates and encourages the children to use ICT in learning to build self-esteem and organisational skills;
3. Assists in the sourcing of ICT resources for the teaching team that will support curriculum planning, and in the allocation, monitoring and management of specified ICT resources;
4. Ensures consistency of ICT use across and between classes;
