## Swimming Coach

The holder of this position provides coaching in swimming sessions to pupils of all levels, ages and ability in accordance with the swimming programme, and discharges other swimming-related and administrative duties as may be directed.

Specifically, amongst all other tasks, the Swimming Coach:

1. Provides effective coaching in swimming sessions and gives special training/attention to pupils who are participating in competitions and to those with hydrophobia and health problems.
2. Assists the Aquatics teacher in planning and organising extra-curricular swimming sessions, competitions, galas and other swimming-related activities.
3. Maintains the safety and cleanliness of the swimming pool and ensures compliance by the pupils with all swimming safety rules and regulations of the School.
4. Prepares, keeps, recommends and submits to the PE teacher periodic evaluation, assessment, time sheets and other reports of pupils detailing their progress in swimming.

Qualifications:

1. Holder of a degree in Physical Education or other relevant fields of study, preferably with swimming accreditation or certification.
2. Effective in working with and training children of different ages and abilities.
3. Energetic, self-motivated and results-oriented.
4. Has excellent communications and people skills.
5. Work experience in a multi-cultural environment is an advantage.
