The holder of this position will assist the Learning Support Coordinator in providing appropriate support to children with special needs. Specifically, amongst other tasks, the Learning Support Assistant:

1. Supports the students in accessing the full range of learning experiences both inside and outside the classroom and assist to provide modified learning materials as required.
2. Assists in planning and preparation of the day-to-day class activities.
3. Contributes to the Individualised Education Programme (IEP) cycle by assisting in setting and implementing targets.
4. Assists in providing regular feedback to Learning Support Coordinator, relevant teachers, parents and outside agencies, if appropriate, about the students' difficulties and progress.

Qualifications:

1. Holder of relevant degrees in Education or Special Education, preferably with above-average academic record from a reputable school.
2. Experience in working with Secondary/Senior School students (ages 11 to 17) is essential.
